Class Policies & Procedures:

<u>Birthday parties-</u> Birthday celebrations are welcome; I ask that you please try to notify me in advance so that I can select the best time for the celebration in our classroom in order to make it special for your child. All treats **must be store bought**, and **cannot be homemade** due to district policy. If your child has a summer birthday, the may celebrate on a day of their choice.

<u>Snack-</u> Each day we will have a designated snack time. Please send your child with a HEALTHY snack. Healthy snacks include but are not limited to granola bars, trail mix, fruit, veggies, crackers etc.

<u>Water bottles-</u> I will allow students to bring a water bottle and keep it on their desks; I suggest getting a reusable water bottle that way your child can refill it throughout the day, but they can do the same with a disposable water bottle. If the water bottle becomes a distraction; students will lose the privilege. Please send your child to school with the water bottle filled each day (in order to eliminate distractions), also your child will be asked to take it home to clean it each night.

<u>Homework/Agendas-</u> The school district will provide assignment agendas and a green folder for each child. Every night (whether there is homework or not) the agenda needs to be signed by a parent/guardian or whomever is supervising the child while they complete their homework. Please encourage your child to complete all assignments; typically we will have homework on a daily basis depending on the material we cover in class. In each child's green folder will be a pocket for "keep home" and another for "homework/return to school". If homework is not turned in a student will lose extra privileges until the assignment is complete.

<u>Grading-</u> The Waverly Central School District has adopted a standards based report card system. The goal is that the report card will be less subjective and even more objective. The report card will list key standards that students should master throughout grade three in various academic subjects and will be assessed using a 1, 2, 3 or 4. In keeping with the standards

based approach, your child will be assessed on these various standards and given a 1, 2, 3 or 4.

If your child earns a...

- 4- Student performs skill or concept beyond NYS and district expectations
- 3- Student can apply the skill or concept correctly and independently, thus meeting NYS and district standards
- 2- Student shows some understanding of the skill or concept, however still relies on teacher assistance and direction to complete the task, thus working toward NYS and district expectations
- 1- Student has been introduced to the skill or concept and consistently requires teacher assistance to complete the task, therefore not meeting NYS and district expectations

<u>Specials-</u> Each month I will send home a calendar with a special schedule for that month on it. The 3rd grade supply list asks that you have your child bring in an old shirt (or something that doesn't matter in case of getting anything on it) for an art smock, students can keep these in school. Also, on days that we have Physical Education students will need sneakers (if not worn, to change into).

<u>Classroom Website-</u> Our classroom website is located off of the Elm Street webpage. I post announcements, updates, copies of forms that I have sent home (in case it gets lost, you can just print it!) and there is a link for you to contact me. My goal for the school year is for it to be an important link of communication between parents and myself, as well as a place that we will be able to display some of the great work your child does. Although I will post some homework information, not all will be put up—**nothing is a substitute for your child's homework agenda**.

Attendance/Absences/Leaving Early-Regular attendance at school is very important in order for your child's progression through third grade. Please make it a priority to have your child to school daily. If your child is absent; please send in an excuse. If your child will be leaving early or comes in late please send in a note as well. All missed work will be gathered, but your child will be responsible for making up the work. If a child is absent and does not bring an excuse, it is constituted as an "unexcused" absence.
